VARIETAL COMPOSITION

Pinot Noir 100%

WINEMAKING

30% whole berry and 70% crushed; fermentation in stainless steel.
Gentle, long pump-overs once a day. Pressed when dry.

VINTAGE NOTES

2019 started out cool and wet. This reduced the overall crop and led to concentrated, flavorful grapes.

AGING

10% new French oak, 15% neutral French oak, and 75% stainless steel

OAK AGING

4-6 months

TASTING NOTES

Excellent Pinot Noir flavors and aromas of dark berries with subtle cherry cola notes. An excellent wine to pair with a variety of dishes.
