Winemaker's Notes

The 2024 Hunted Zinfandel embodies the intensity and raw character that has made Lodi a benchmark for the varietal. Harvested from old-vine blocks rooted deep in sandy loam soils, this wine reflects both the richness of the region's climate and the precision of small-lot winemaking. Grapes were hand-picked at peak ripeness, then fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel before being aged in a mix of American and French oak barrels to enhance texture and complexity.

Tasting Profile

- **Aromas:** Ripe blackberry, black cherry, and raspberry preserve, accented by subtle notes of vanilla bean, cracked pepper, and cedar.
- **Palate:** Full-bodied and fruit-driven, with layers of dark plum, cocoa powder, and baking spice. The mouthfeel is broad and velvety, supported by fine tannins and a balanced thread of acidity that carries the wine through to a long, lingering finish.
- **Structure:** Bold yet approachable, with a smooth texture that makes it versatile and inviting.

Vintage Character

The 2024 growing season in Lodi was marked by warm days and cool nights, allowing grapes to ripen fully while maintaining acidity. This balance delivers a Zinfandel that is both powerful and structured, highlighting the unique expression of the appellation.
