2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES

Huge aromatic complexity, with sweet, ripe cassis and black currants, roasted plums, and grilled black fruits. On the palate, soft, ripe black and red fruits and fresh acids give way to elegant tannins, providing framing and structure. This is a wonderful, utterly beautiful Cabernet.

VINEYARDS

Our Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon provides us the opportunity to create a classic Napa Cabernet blended from top sites throughout the valley. The Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced primarily from the eastern edge of Rutherford, providing a core of dense, lush, mocha-laced dark fruit. In this vintage, for the first time, we acquired a touch of Howell Mountain Merlot from one of the highest vineyards in all of Napa Valley, adding vibrant energy and textural nuance. A touch of Franc from Oakville adds a beguiling floral lift and notes of espresso.

WINEMAKING

17-33 day fermentations in 15% oak, 5% Concrete, 80% stainless steel. 22 months in French Oak - 62% new.
